Mrs. G , 67, was admitted to Fairhaven Healthcare Center in November 2006 for short term rehabilitation after sustaining left hip and wrist fractures after falling at home. Mrs. G had surgical repair of the fractures and was given non-weight bearing status for her arm.

Prior to coming to rehab, Mrs. G lived with her husband and was fully independent with mobility and activities of daily living (ADLs).

At admission, Mrs. G required maximal assistance of staff for transfers, mobility, bathing and dressing. She was unable to ambulate or propel a wheelchair.

Mrs. G had a tough challenge in front of her to improve her level of function. Mrs. G received therapy daily and real progress began to show!

When Mrs. G was able to be discharged home in early January 2007, the difference was remarkable. She was walking 125 feet with a walker, climbing 6 stairs with a cane, transferring with supervision, performing all ADLs with modified independence and working hard at strengthening programs. Three months after discharge, Mrs. G. is now walking with just a cane!
